Dear Mr Strophair,

RE: STOLEN ITEMS / PARIS

Please find enclosed a letter from French authorities in PARIS regarding the recovery of stolen items.

The letter outlines that in order for you to collect the items recovered you will have to do so either in person by attending the police offices in Paris where the items are currently held and present this letter along with identification. You have one (1) year in which to do this from the 23/11/2004.

If you choose not to collect the items prior to this date they will effectively be destroyed by French authorities.

Or you may have another party pick up the items on your behalf. This will involve you providing the party with this letter along with a copy of your own identification (Passport) details. The party will also be required to present their own identification prior to having French authorities release the items to them on your behalf.

It may be an option to contact by phone or fax the French authorities directly, the numbers are on the bottom of their letter, to see whether they will forward the items directly to the West Australian Police for your collection, with any costs involved being paid by yourself.

It has obviously been worthwhile for you to have your Pre-Paid Legal Membership in this instance, as French authorities are aware of our services and have recognised your membership card and have contacted us directly on your behalf.

I trust that you can sort the matter out and recover your items in due course. If you require any further assistance please do not hesitate to contact our office.
